

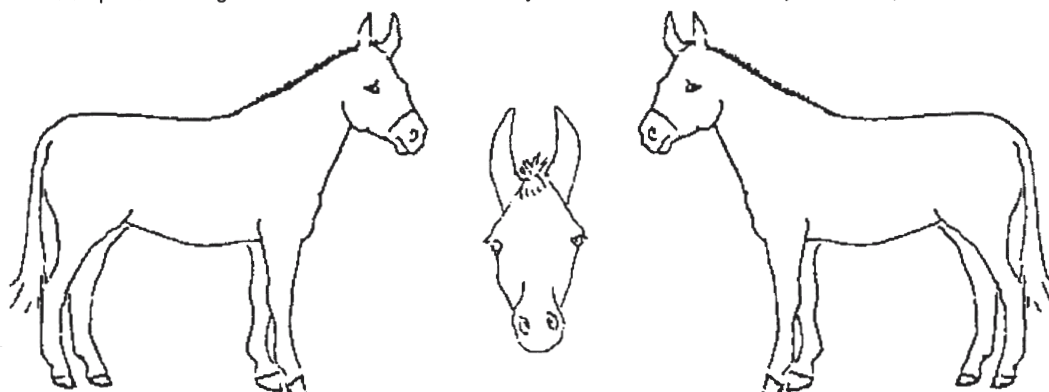

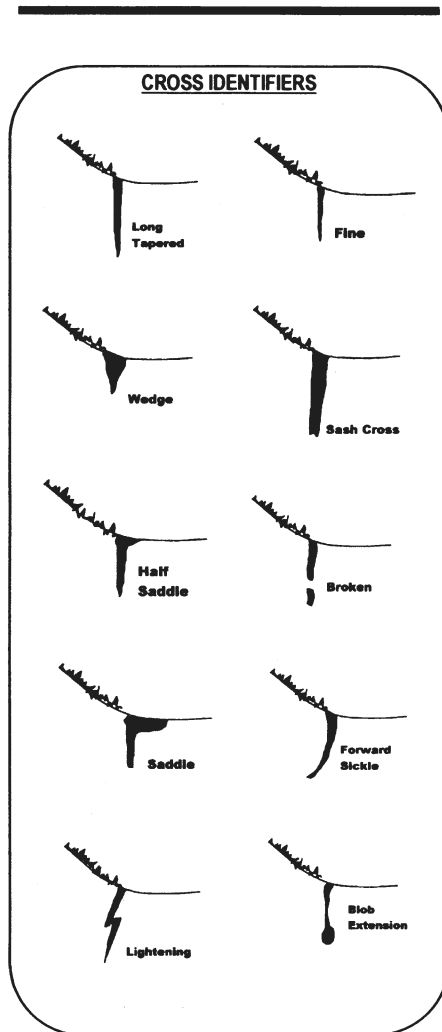

Description of Spotting or Broken Color

- White hip spots only
 - White hip and flank spots
 - White hip, flank and belly spots
 - White barrel, flank and hip spots
 - White points over entire body
 - Mixed evenly dark and white
 - Mostly White, large dark patches
 - Mostly White, small dark spots

- Spot edges sharp
 - Spot edges overlap
 - Spot edges overlap with roan edges
 - Roan edges on small scattered spots
 - Unusual spot locations

Cross and Stripe
